



Scholarship

Sachem Youth Soccer League has established a scholarship fund for those graduating seniors who have participated in our programs for at least five (5) seasons. You must be eligible for high school graduation and will be attending college or trade school.

Additionally, serious consideration is given to the well rounded candidate who has participated in volunteer projects and/or community service.

If you wish to be considered for an SYSL scholarship, read the eligibility requirements and complete the application in its entirety. It is the responsibility of the applicant to forward all necessary materials, to the Scholarship Committee. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible to apply for a Sachem Youth Soccer League Scholarship, all applicants must:

1. Be a graduating High School Senior the year of the application.
2. Plan on attending a University, College or Trade School in the fall following graduation.
3. Have participated in the Long Island Junior Soccer League, Inc. for at least five seasons. Participation need not have been in successive seasons, but should include at least one season of participation during the applicant's junior or senior year of High School.
4. Have been involved in extracurricular school activities.
5. Have been involved in community service. APPLICATION: All applications must be completed and received at the LIJSL office no later than April 15th of your high school graduation year. Please Note: If you choose to submit the application using the website form, applicants must mail ALL required items (i.e. essay, resume, letters of recommendation etc.) to the Scholarship Committee.

REQUIREMENTS / CHECK LIST:

Before mailing your application, be certain that you have included the following:

1. Application
2. Letters of recommendation, minimum of two, one must be from a soccer coach and the second from a person who knows you well (i.e. teacher, school administrator, employer, community service director, religious leader)
3. Current transcript and a copy of SAT/ACT scores
4. Brief resume including description of awards, achievements, employment, school clubs, community service and volunteer work. From age 14 to present.
5. Include a soccer resume, outlining your SYSL participation, tournament participation, high school participation and any awards received for soccer and the coaches and clubs for whom you have played.
